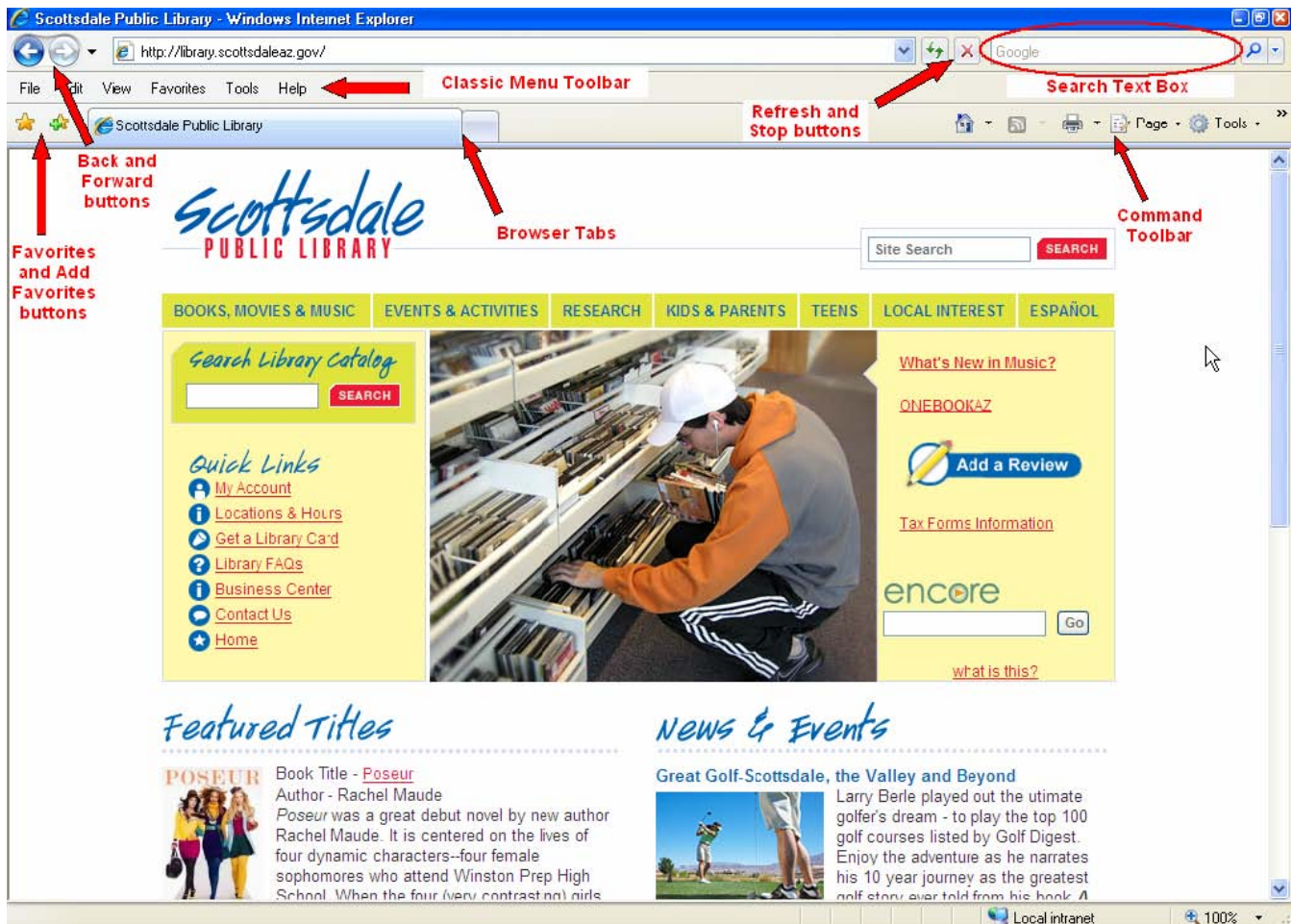

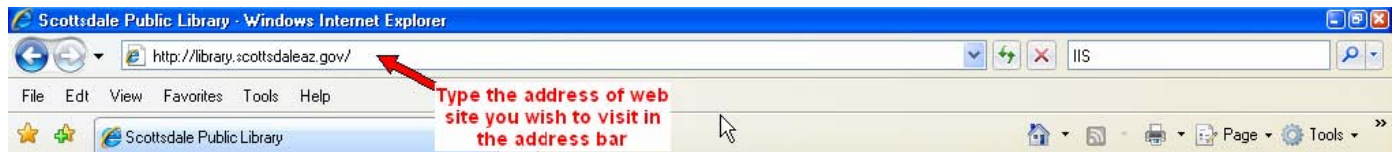

Internet Explorer 7 Overview:














Internet Explorer 7 Address Bar

If you know a web site address, type it in the Address Bar and push the Enter key. `http://` is automatically added by Internet Explorer.



Commonly Used Internet Explorer 7 Buttons

-  **Back/Forward** can navigate back or forward one page at a time.
-  **Favorites** can be used to list your bookmarked web sites.
-  **Add Favorites** to save and organize your favorite web sites.
-  **Refresh** to reload web pages.
-  **Stop** to stop the browser.
-  **Home** will take you to your home page(s). Click the small arrow to the right of the button to add, remove, or change home pages.
-  **RSS Feed** can quickly add a web page RSS feed. Click the small arrow to the right of the button to choose and access feeds.

-  **Print** sends the active window/tab on your browser to the printer. Click the small arrow to the right of the Print icon to preview the print job or change printer setting.
-  **Page** gives you control over items including text size, sending a page to someone in an email, and opening a new browser window.
-  **Tools** gives you access to Internet Options, add ons, popup blocker, lets you configure the toolbars, and allows you to delete the browsing history.
-  Click the small chevron button to the right of the Tools icon for Additional functions. These function icons can be added to the Command Toolbar by right-clicking the small chevron button and choosing Customize Command Bar.
